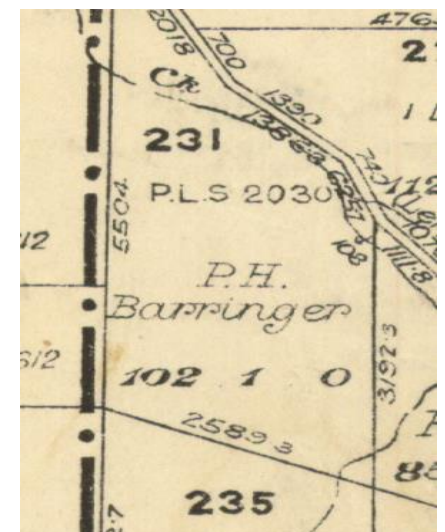
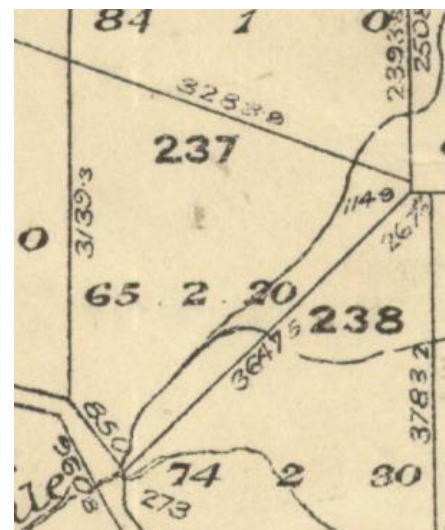
**Further information:** Embarked on "Sardinia" on 13/10/1918 to return to Australia.

After surrendering the Lot 231, it was then occupied by Philip Henry Barringer, a soldier settler, orchardist and his wife Jessie. The farm eventually became part of the Passchendaele Forest Plantation. It is believed that years later the house was moved to Poole's farm just down the road.
